

## Attica Horse Show Guidelines and Rules 2021

Youth (17 & under)	\$6	Ribbons 1 <sup>st</sup> - 4 <sup>th</sup> *payback 1-6 depending on # in class
Walk-Trot (12 & under)	\$5	Ribbons 1 <sup>st</sup> - 4 <sup>th</sup> *payback 1-6 depending on # in class
Lead-Line (7 & under)	\$5 Office Fee	Ribbons 1 <sup>st</sup> - 4 <sup>th</sup> *no payback

\*Champion and Reserve Champion Awarded each show for Open, Youth, and Walk-Trot in each division\*  
\*Payback 70%

- Age is as of May 1, 2021
- Current negative Coggins dated 2020 or 2021 and current rabies certificate must be presented at sign-up
- Sign up begins at 7:30am and the show will begin promptly at 9am. Entries will close 15 minutes before the division starts. Announcements will be made when sign-ups are closing for each division
- Per NYS Law no person under 18 years of age shall ride a horse without a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM standards.
- Walk-Trot horse/rider combo cannot compete in any other division. Walk-Trot classes are intended for inexperienced riders under the age of 12 that are not yet capable of showing at a lope or canter.
- Lead-Line riders must be accompanied by an adult
- Riders competing in showmanship may dress in either English or Western attire. Rider will choose at sign up if their points go towards western or English.
- No stallions in youth or walk-trot classes and the Attica Horse Show Management reserves the right to excuse unruly or dangerous horses
- Show management reserves the right to split, combine, or cancel any class
- Judges' decisions are final. Any question, protest or comment regarding the conduct or decision of a class must be directed to the show management. Under no circumstances is the judge to be approached
- Points awarded to top 6 riders in each class
- Points accumulate towards horse/rider combo
- Rider must participate in 3 out of 5 shows for yearend awards (Banquet date TBA)
- ARSA and its volunteers are not responsible for accidents or loss to horse, rider, personal property or spectators
